

#### STAR, IDAHO

#### **SWAN FALLS DAM**


A site to see is Swan Falls Dam, which is located at the south side of the Snake River. You will fall in love with these beautiful canyon views. Enjoy the outdoor life fishing for smallmouth bass on the Snake River or

take an adventure on the beautiful hiking orbiking tails along the canyon.

#### **BIRDS OF PREY**

One attraction you will want to check out in Kuna is the Snake River Birds of Prey National Conservation. It is home to the greatest concentration of nesting birds of prey in North America, and perhaps, even the world. Free of charge, you'll get to learn about the 485,000 acres that protect North America's largest population of nesting raptors and other birds of prey, such as shorebirds, songbirds, and waterfowl. The best time to spot any of the 20 species of raptors here is from mid-March through June.





#### NAMPA, IDAHO

Nampa Idaho is one of the fastest-growing communities in the state, with a population of over 100,000 residents as of 2020. With it's economic opportunities, affordable housing, and recreational life - it's no wonder why so many people are choosing to live in Nampa.

Nampa was establish as a very well known railroad town. The Nampa train depot brought many visitors, as well as, growth to the town.

#### PARKS AND RECREATION

Nampa ID is famous for its extensive parks system, which boasts 24 local parks. The largest and oldest park in the system is Lakeview Park. The park consists of 44 acres, and visitors love to walk along the tree-lined paths and enjoy the scenic rose garden, which

is a favored spot for outdoor weddings in the community. Lakeview Park also has an amphitheater where outdoor concerts are hosted during the summer months. The park is complete with a playground, a water park and a picnic area that is available for reservations.

#### **FORD IDAHO CENTER**

The Ford Idaho Center in Nampa is home to many concerts, trade shows, and sporting events. Every year it hosts the Snake River Stampede, which is considered one of the nation's top rodeos, and boy howdy, if you haven't seen professional rodeo, it something to see!

Indian Creek Plaza is located in the core area of the downtown Caldwell. The Plaza is centered around retail stores, restaurants, an outdoor ice skating rink in the shape of a ribbon, state for concerts, live entertainment, movies, and a splash pad for outdoor water play.

#### **COLLEGE OF IDAHO**

The Canyon County Fair, the Caldwell Night Rodeo (a national top 5 ranked event) and the Buckaroo Breakfast are just a few of the events celebrated by the City of Caldwell.

Nestled in the scenic Snake River Valley AVA, the Sunnyslope Wine Trail boasts 16 wineries and vineyards, award-winning wines, and intimate tasting experiences, all framed by panoramic views.

#### **BABBY FARM**

Babby Farms is a non-profit farm that is home to over 150 animals. All the animals are born in the United States and have been donated from zoos around the country; many of which are effected by natural disasters and need a safe place for their animals to live.

According to online statistics. Middleton school district is ranked #2 in Canyon County for athletics and #19 of the best school districts in Idaho.


#### **CLASSIC CAR SHOW**
